Acts of the accused associated with this Offense: From August 2008 to February 2010, the defendant, who is a dentist, issued 86 medically unjustified Percocet (a schedule 2, controlled substance) prescriptions to four (4) staff members and two (2) patients, which were filled and the Percocets were delivered back to the defendant for his own personal consumption and/or others. These prescriptions were issued at the defendant's former dental office located at 845 Kedron Avenue, Morton, PA (Delaware County). The 86 Percocet prescriptions amounted to a total of 1,508 tablets.

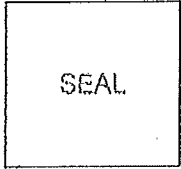

That the Defendant, Glenn H. 


